“People think German wine is complicated, but ask them what they think of Burgundy, and they love it. You can’t approve one and not the other. It takes some learning, but I don’t think it’s too much to ask. Nothing simple was ever very satisfying” - KATHARINA PRÜM



Slate, steepness, and its optimal exposure are the winning combination. Named after the sundials in the vineyards built in 1842 by Jodocus Prüm. These are the top of the pops vineyards, making the most notable and royal examples of this illustrious grape.

Attractiveness is the word here; racy acidity and pronounced minerality are features of this underrated vineyard. Accessible early and with potential to age, this site really does give the best of both worlds.

The orientation means longer sun exposure. The Badstube typically produces floral, delicate and mineral driven wines. They are full, lush and tend to give lots of desirable fruit characters.

German wine labels are complicated, terminology incomprehensible, but the wine is amongst the best in the world showcasing every nuance of terroir with ravishing delicacy and absolute clarity and transparency.

Surely German wines have done enough to bust the myth that all Riesling is akin to sweet Liebfraumilch, aka Blue Nun. We certainly think so.

SHOREHOUSE GUIDE TO UNDERSTANDING

GERMAN WINE SPEAK - YAH

TROCKEN: literally 'dry'

KABINETT: lighter styles of wine an often off-dry

SPÄTLESE: picked one week after Kabinett grapes - typically fruity, medium-sweet

GRBOES GEWACHES: top of the pops; high quality dry wine from selected sites.

AUSTRIA

Of all the epicenters for Riesling production, perhaps the most overlooked is Austria, with Germany and Alsace so close by and the nations patron grape, Grüner Veltliner, often taking center stage; Riesling is unfairly left behind. Although not as widely known, its virtues are many. Producing structured wines of great energy, with precise, finely etched flavours, it is a combination of a distinct richness coupled with a coiled, tensile strength that earns it a rightful place.



CHABLIS

"The only thing truly original in the world of wine is the underlying terroir and I have nothing else interesting to add. Anyone can copy anyone else's techniques so what else is there to make great wines? I believe the answer is simple: Terroir. I want to work only with the fruit from old vines and even then, only old vines that are planted exclusively within the original boundaries of Chablis. If I respect these things, it will be almost impossible to make bad wine."

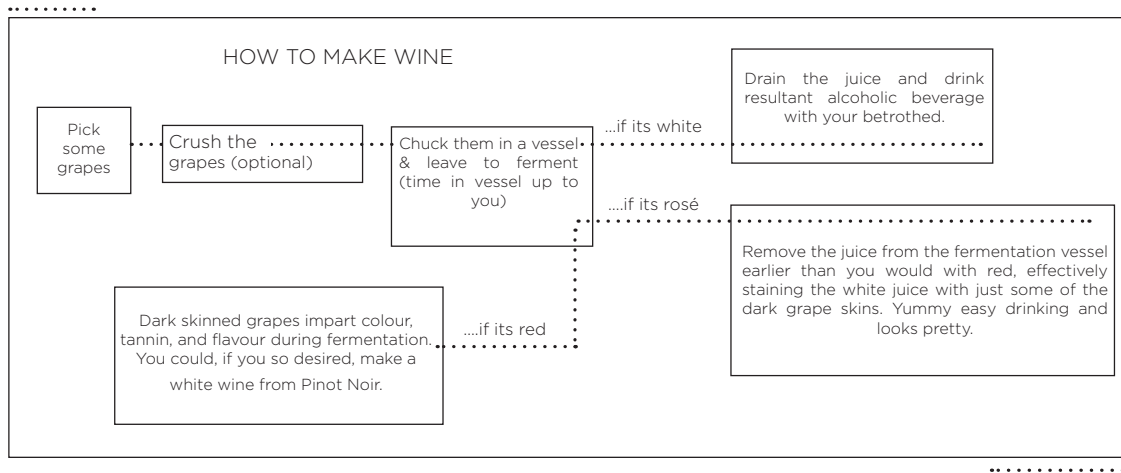

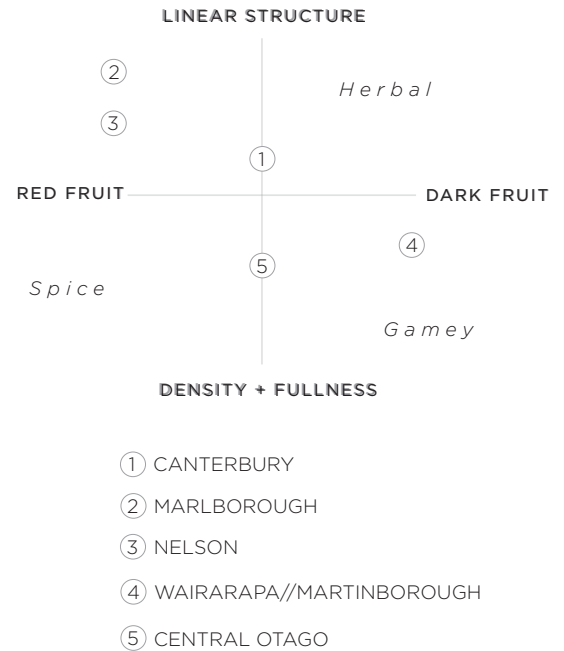

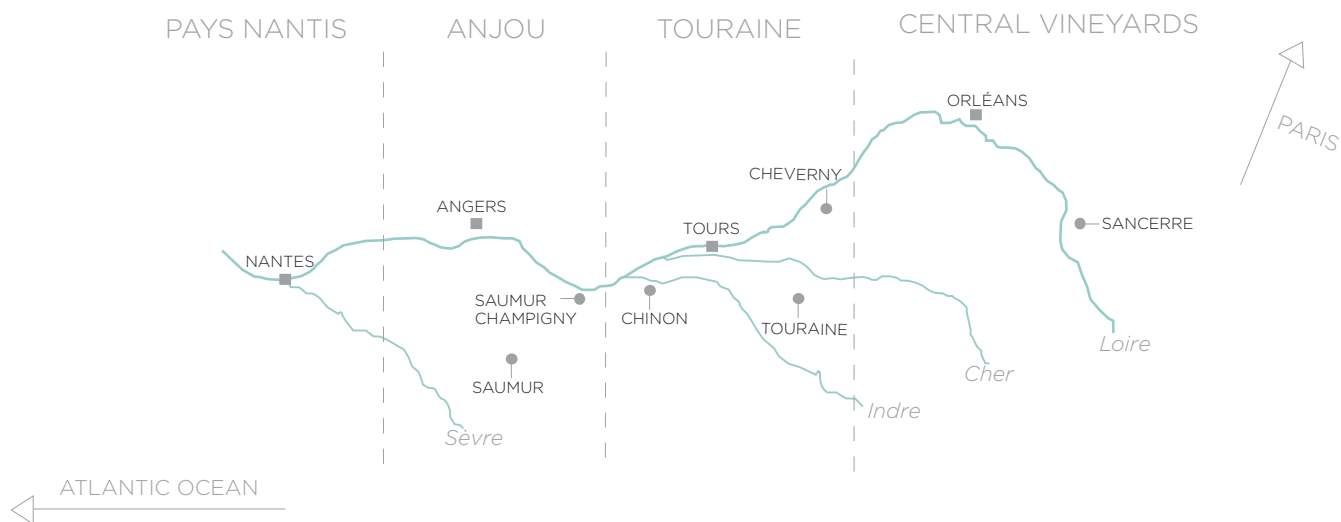

The word is increasingly misused in place of variety. Varietal glassware and varietal labelling are describing the object.

E.g. Pinot Noir is a grape variety that should be served in varietal glassware.
