MOSEL RIESLING

"People think German wine is complicated, but ask them what they think of Burgundy, and they love it. You can't approve one and not the other. It takes some learning, but I don't think it's too much to ask. Nothing simple was ever very satisfying" - KATHARINA PRÜM



Slate, steepness, and its optimal exposure are the winning combination. Named after the sundials in the vineyards built in 1842 by Jodocus Prüm. These are the top of the pops vineyards, making the most notable and royal examples of this illustrious grape.

Attractiveness is the word here; racy acidity and pronounced minerality are features of this underrated vineyard. Accessible early and with potential to age, this site really does give the best of both worlds.

The orientation means longer sun exposure. The Badstube typically produces floral, delicate and mineral driven wines. They are full, lush and tend to give lots of desirable fruit characters.

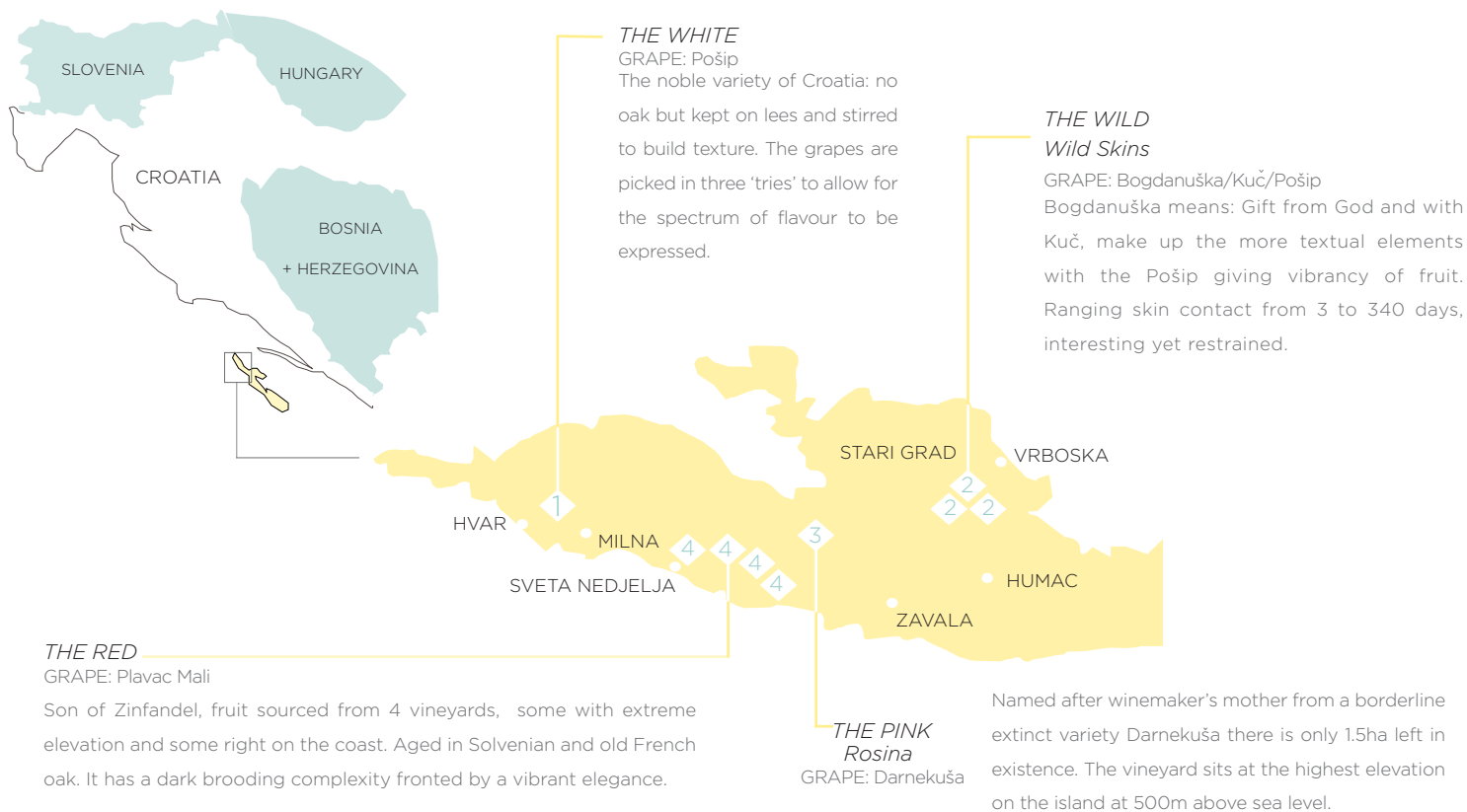

WHAT IS A JURA?

Less of a what and more of a where, the Jura is France's smallest wine region, under half the size of Margaret River it's tucked just below Alsace. Named for the Jurassic soils on which the vineyards lie on, it comes complete with its own grapes and styles of wine, truly one of the most unique wine appellations in the world.

OUILLÉ

Barrels are topped up to keep the wine fresh and free from oxidation

VIN DE PAILLE

Literally translates to 'straw wine' grapes are picked and dried to create lush sweetness

VIN JAUNE

A truly unique style of wine in every way, made with the indigenous savagnin grape, it is left in oxidative barrels for 6 years and then bottled in 620ml bottles called Clavins

DOMAINE ROLET—Established in 1942 by Désiré Rolet, it is now one of the largest estates in the Jura, making interesting, approachable and delicious examples.

HOW TO MAKE WINE

Pick some grapes

Crush the grapes (optional)

Chuck them in a vessel & leave to ferment (time in vessel up to you)

....if its white

Drain the juice and drink resultant alcoholic beverage with your betrothed.

....if its rosé

Remove the juice from the fermentation vessel earlier than you would with red, effectively staining the white juice with just some of the dark grape skins. Yummy easy drinking and looks pretty.

Dark skinned grapes impart colour, tannin, and flavour during fermentation. You could, if you so desired, make a white wine from Pinot Noir.

THE MAGNA CARTA OF NATURAL WINE

A STAB AT DEFINING THE UNDEFINABLE

Natural Wine has no legally binding definition, making it murky waters (or murky grape juice) to begin with.

Instead of being a set of rules or processes, it becomes a philosophical approach or mantra: 'Less is more.'

Grapes should be sourced from sustainable vineyards, preferably organic or biodynamic.

Wine is treated with a 'hands off' approach - meaning there is minimal human intervention - lazy buggers.

The word variety is a noun. When speaking about wine, a variety is a type of vine or a type of grape.

For example, Pinot Noir is a grape variety. Many people will use the word varietal when they really mean variety. Varietal is a descriptive term.

The word is increasingly misused in place of variety. Varietal glassware and varietal labelling are describing the object.

E.g. Pinot Noir is a grape variety that should be served in varietal glassware.
