The domaine is now in its third generation, run by Olivier Bonville, who grew up in the business working side-by-side with his parents, Ingrid and Gilles. The fruit is sourced exclusively from Grand Cru villages, Avize & Oger producing a vibrant Chardonnay-driven Champagne displaying the purity of the region with pristine fruit, weight and balance.

"People think German wine is complicated, but ask them what they think of Burgundy, and they love it. You can't approve one and not the other. It takes some learning, but I don't think it's too much to ask. Nothing simple was ever very satisfying" - KATHARINA PRÜM



Slate, steepness, and its optimal exposure are the winning combination. Named after the sundials in the vineyards built in 1842 by Jodocus Prüm. These are the top of the pops vineyards, making the most notable and royal examples of this illustrious grape.

Attractiveness is the word here; racy acidity and pronounced minerality are features of this underrated vineyard. Accessible early and with potential to age, this site really does give the best of both worlds.

The orientation means longer sun exposure. The Badstube typically produces floral, delicate and mineral driven wines. They are full, lush and tend to give lots of desirable fruit characters.

TROCKEN: literally 'dry'

KABINETT: lighter styles of wine an often off-dry

SPÄTLESE: picked one week after Kabinett grapes - typically fruity,
medium-sweet

GRÜBOES GEWACHES: top of the pops; high quality dry wine from selected sites.

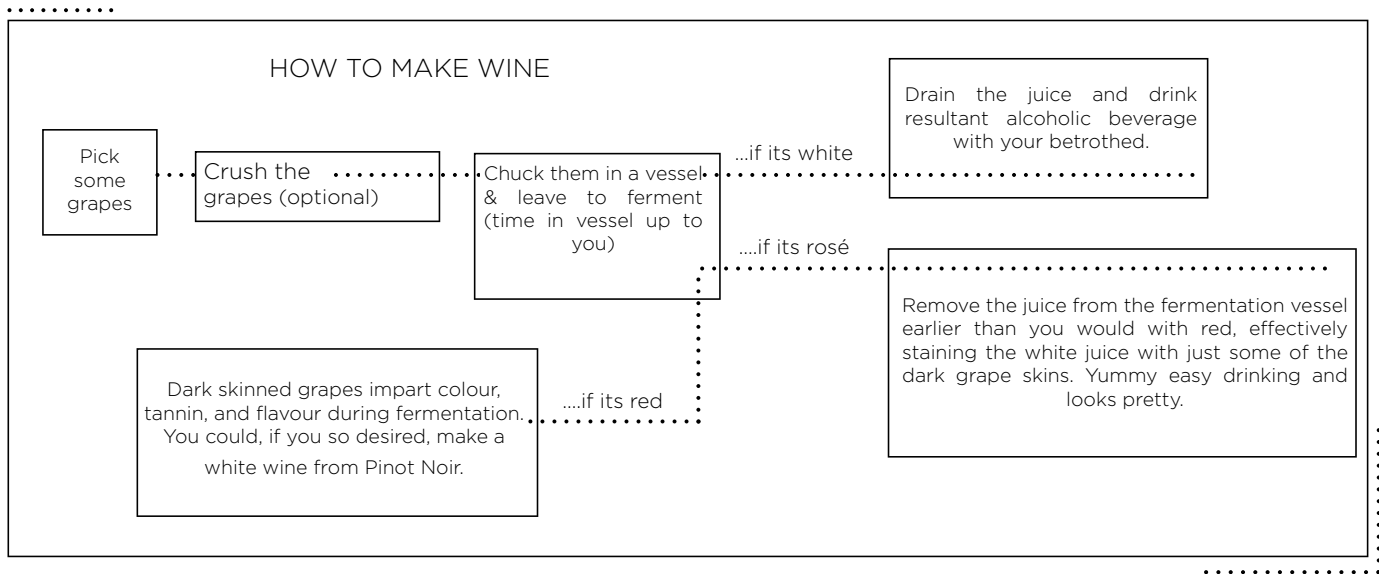

THE MAGNA CARTA OF NATURAL WINE A STAB AT DEFINING THE UNDEFINABLE

Natural Wine has no legally binding definition, making it murky waters (or murky grape juice) to begin with.

Instead of being a set of rules or processes, it becomes a philosophical approach or mantra: 'Less is more.'

Grapes should be sourced from sustainable vineyards, preferably organic or biodynamic

Wine is treated with a 'hands off' approach - meaning there is minimal human intervention - nothing added and nothing is taken away..... lazy buggers.

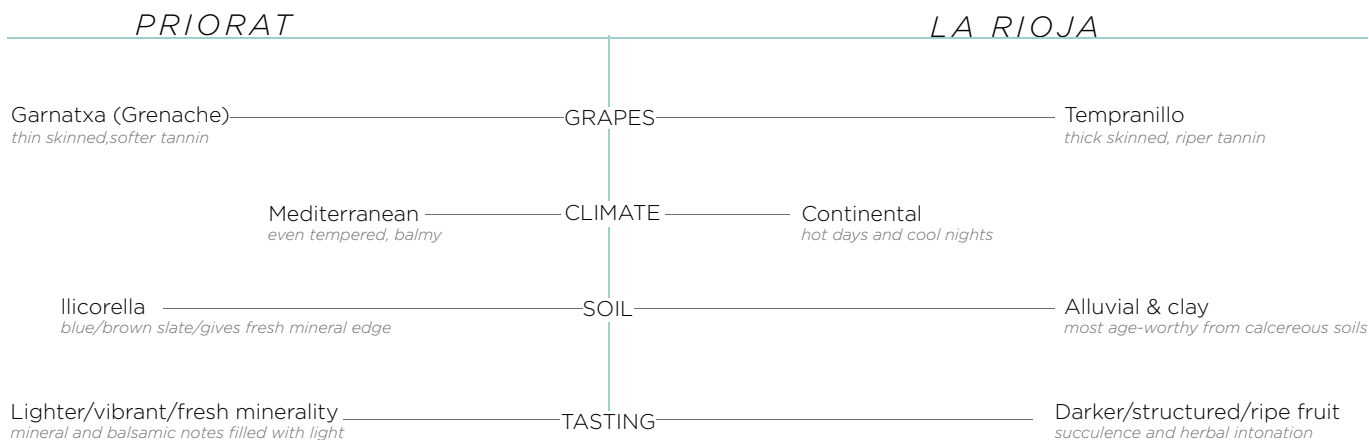
We love Jancis (Master of Wine) and we think she knows her stuff. This is her take on the whole misuse of the words. The word variety is a noun.

When speaking about wine, a variety is a type of vine or a type of grape.

For example, Pinot Noir is a grape variety. Many people will use the word varietal when they really mean variety. Varietal is a descriptive term. The word is increasingly misused in place of variety. Varietal glassware and varietal labelling are describing the object.

E.g. Pinot Noir is a grape variety that should be served in varietal glassware.
