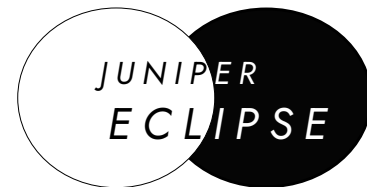

Before starting his own business, Mauro worked as a chemist for one of Italy's top pharmaceutical companies, developing flavours and aromas. It is his ability to identify and understand the ideal assemblage, that makes his vermouths layered and complex beyond compare. Mauro's passion also extends to the base wine, which historically has been low quality table wines, however, these are crafted in his own winery from native Piedmontese varieties.

### EL MARCO + THE PALOMINO FINO CONTINUUM

The word Sherry has become problematic - to ask for a 'Sherry' doesn't tell if you are getting a wine that is white or dark, dry or sweet. This is El Marco and it starts with a range of dry white wines made from the Palomino grape, including those that are fortified and those that are not - hence the continuum. There are also dry, amber-coloured Palomino styles. These are fortified wines with a marked developmental character due to ageing: Amontillado, Oloroso, Palo Cortado. It is complex and often hard to understand, both in a literal and tasting sense - but trust the process and you'll be rewarded.

# MOSEL RIESLING

"People think German wine is complicated, but ask them what they think of Burgundy, and they love it. You can't approve one and not the other. It takes some learning, but I don't think it's too much to ask. Nothing simple was ever very satisfying"

Slate, steepness, and its optimal exposure are the winning combination. Named after the sundials in the vineyards built in 1842 by Jodocus Prüm. These are the top of the pops vineyards, making the most notable and royal examples of this illustrious grape.

Attractiveness is the word here; racy acidity and pronounced minerality are features of this underrated vineyard. Accessible early and with potential to age, this site really does give the best of both worlds.

The orientation means longer sun exposure. The Badstube typically produces floral, delicate and mineral driven wines. They are full, lush and tend to give lots of desirable fruit characters.

German wine labels are complicated, terminology incomprehensible, but the wine is amongst the best in the world showcasing every nuance of terroir with ravishing delicacy and absolute clarity and transparency.

Surely German wines have done enough to bust the myth that all Riesling is akin to sweet Liebfraumilch, aka Blue Nun. We certainly think so.

### SHOREHOUSE GUIDE TO UNDERSTANDING GERMAN WINE SPEAK - YAH

TROCKEN: literally 'dry'

KABINETT: lighter styles of wine and often off-dry (lightly sweet)

SPÄTLESE: picked one week after Kabinett grapes - typically fruity, medium-sweet

GROßES GEWACHES: top of the pops; high quality dry wine from selected sites.

Are there lifted florals or noticeable vibrant fruits driving the wine, hence displaying pronounced aromas. Or is the wine more about textural aspects that have a generosity and defined palate weight that can build a savory framework around the wine. Now all that palava aside it is not to say that an aromatic wine cannot be textural or vice versa but more so that which is the leading playmaker in the glass.*

We love Jancis (Master of Wine) and we think she knows her stuff. This is her take on the whole misuse of the words. The word variety is a noun. When speaking about wine, a variety is a type of vine or a type of grape.

For example, Pinot Noir is a grape variety. Many people will use the word varietal when they really mean variety. Varietal is a descriptive term. The word is increasingly misused in place of variety. Varietal glassware and varietal labelling are describing the object.

E.g. Pinot Noir is a grape variety that should be served in varietal glassware.

Fermentation begins. Halt fermentation by addition of a neutral grain spirit.

Note to Self: the earlier the addition, the sweeter the wine
